John deSteiguer became the seventh president of Oklahoma Christian University (OC) on May 1, 2012.

A native of Tahlequah, Oklahoma, deSteiguer studied political science at Northeastern State University, University of the West Indies and law at Pepperdine University. He served Northeastern State University, his alma mater, as its director of development from 1993 to 2002 before coming to Oklahoma Christian.

deSteiguer's served nine years as OC's chief advancement officer, most recently as senior vice president for advancement. He was inaugurated in special ceremonies on

August 27, 2012.

He married Darla, his college sweetheart, in June 1986. They both earned juris doctorate degrees, magna cum laude, from the Pepperdine University School of Law.

John and Darla live in Edmond, where John is a deacon and frequent Bible class teacher at Memorial Road Church of Christ. Their daughter Abby attended Oklahoma Christian.
